He took everyone as equal and saw the good in them

He mixed with all classes of people

He was inclusive

He was compassionate

His disciples were ordinary and had flaws

He was passionate about his belief - loving others

He worked hard

He was 100% - no half measures

He held unshakeable truth

People wanted to be with him

He 'walked' with and among ordinary people

He used practical stories and relevant images
